Arrangements for the Christmas Concert on Tuesday evening, December 8th at 6.30

Nursery and Reception children should arrive at the ***Assembly room*** at the side of the stage by 6.10. Nursery children should be collected from the Studio on the top floor (near the bar) at the end of the evening. Following their performance the Reception class will sit in the Great Hall to see the remainder of the concert and should be collected from their seats at the end of the evening.

Years 1 and 2 children should arrive at the ***Café Piazza*** by 6.10. Following their performance they will sit in the Great Hall to watch the remainder of the performance. Pupils should be collected from their seats at the end of the evening.

Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 pupils (apart from the band) should arrive at the ***Gallery*** by 6.15 and should be collected from the stage at the end of the evening. The band should arrive near the stage by 5.45 as they will be performing before the concert (5.50 - 6.10)

The performance should finish around 8 o'clock. Programmes will be available from the Great Hall on the evening of the performance – adults £4.00, secondary school pupils £1.50 (Ysgol Gymraeg pupils - free of charge)

Rehearsals for the Christmas Concert – pupils will visit the Great Hall for rehearsals on Monday, December 7th. Foundation Stage during the morning and Key Stage 2 during the afternoon. (Nursery afternoon pupils will be rehearsing in the school hall during the afternoon)

Foundation Stage – details already distributed

Key Stage 2 – all pupils to wear black trousers, black shoes and the red or white school polo shirt with any colour tinsel. Many Key Stage 2 pupils (especially Years 5 and 6) have already received guidance by the class teachers.
